Common Defects

Damage by:

- 1. Spreading when, the scales at the tip are opening but not to the extent that the heart is exposed.
- 2. Misshapen, when not excessively long and pointed.

Serious damage by:

- 1. Spreading when, practically all of the scales have spread, exposing the flower parts in the center of the bud.
- 2. Overdeveloped when the artichoke has a brownish color; the scales are tough, leathery, and stringy and the flower in the center of the bud has turned dark pink or purple and become fuzzy.
