Common Defects

Damage by:

- 1) Broken beans when,
 - a) There is one break present in the thick portion of the bean or one break at each end in the thin portion of the bean;
 - b) Any break that is materially affected by dirt or discoloration;
 - c) Any break that is ragged and materially detracts from the appearance; or
 - d) Unless otherwise specified, the remaining portion of the bean is less than 3 ½ inches in length (5 ½ inches for pole type beans).

Serious damage by:

- 1) Broken beans when,
 - a) There is a break on each end in the thick portion of the bean;
 - b) Any break is seriously affected by dirt or discoloration;
 - c) Any break is ragged and seriously detracts from the appearance or exposes a seed; or
 - d) Unless otherwise specified, the remaining portion of the bean is less than 3 inches in length (5 inches for pole type beans).
