15% total, including 3% decay

Common Defects

Damage by:

- 1. Scars when aggregating more than the area of a circle 5/8 inch in diameter on a cucumber 6 inches in length.
- 2. Color when less than two-thirds of the surface of the cucumber is of a medium green or darker color, and that at least a light green color extends to within one-half inch of the blossom end on one side of the cucumber.
- 3. Sunken area when exceeding 3/8 inch in diameter.
- 4. Yellowing when any spot of yellow color predominates over the green on any portion of the cucumber, or when the appearance is materially affected.

Serious damage by:

- 1. Scars when aggregating more than the area of a circle 1 inch in diameter on a cucumber 6 inches in length.
- 2. Color when less than one-half of the surface of the cucumber is of a light green or darker color.
- 3. Sunken area when exceeding 5/8 inch in diameter.
- 4. Yellowing when the aggregate area of yellow color, which predominates over the green, exceeds that of a circle 1/2 inch in diameter, or when the appearance is seriously affected.
