Tolerances

10% total defects, including 5% for serious damage, including 2% for decay affecting walls and calyxes.

Good Delivery Guidelines

15% total, including 8% serious damage, including 4% decay

Common Defects

Damage by:

- 1. Scars when more than 3/8 inch diameter.
- 2. Sunburn when causing discoloration which affects an aggregate area exceeding 15% of the surface of the pepper.
- 3. Blossom End Rot when a pepper has a single spot more than 3/8 inch in diameter.
- 4. Bruising when more than 5/8 inch in diameter.
- 5. Silvery white discoloration when more than 10% of the surface is affected.

Serious damage by:

- 1. Scars when more than 3/4 inch diameter.
- 2. Sunburn when causing discoloration which affects an aggregate area exceeding 25% of the surface of the pepper.
- 3. Blossom End Rot when a pepper has a single spot more than 3/4 inch in diameter.
- 4. Bruising when more than 1 inch in diameter, or if crushed or broken.
- 5. Silvery white discoloration when more than 25% of the surface is affected.
