<u>Tolerances</u> 10% total defects, including 5% for serious damage, including 1% for decay.

## **Good Delivery Guidelines**

15% total, including 8% serious damage, including 3% decay

## **Common Defects**

Damage by:

- 1. Bruising when any indentation is more than 1/8 inch in depth or exceeds an area of 1/2 inch in diameter.
- 2. Cuts when the cut extends into the flesh or when materially affecting the appearance.
- 3. Discoloration when light brown discoloration affects an aggregate area of more than 10% of the surface.
- 4. Scuffing when affecting more than 10% of the surface, or when affecting more than 5% of the surface when accompanied by discoloration.

Serious damage by:

- 1. Bruising when any indentation is more than 1/4 inch in depth or exceeds an area of 3/4 inch in diameter.
- 2. Cuts when seriously affecting the appearance.
- 3. Discoloration when light brown discoloration affects an aggregate area of more than 20% of the surface.
- 4. Scuffing when affecting more than 20% of the surface, or when affecting more than 10% of the surface when accompanied by discoloration.
